



## **TriHydro Builds New Corporate Headquarters in Laramie**

LARAMIE, Wyoming, October 16, 2003 -- Next year when TriHydro Corporation ("TriHydro") celebrates its 20th year of business, it will do so at its new 23,000 square-foot headquarters in the Laramie River Business Park in West Laramie. The relocation from multiple offices in Laramie will enable the nationally-recognized environmental and engineering consulting company to consolidate and enhance its corporate operations, while providing a state-of-the-art working environment for its 76 local employees.

Land for the new building closed on Friday, October 10, 2003, with groundbreaking slated to begin as soon as later this week. The new building, to be constructed by Laramie-based Delta Construction, is due for completion in summer of 2004.

What started as a two-man firm in 1984, has grown into a successful company of over 100 employees nationwide. TriHydro's relocation goal was to remain in Laramie, but to move to a building with ample square footage to house its current employees, while at the same time providing space for future growth. Working closely with Laramie Economic Development Corporation ("LEDC"), TriHydro found the ideal opportunity with the Laramie River Business Park. LEDC provided TriHydro multiple incentives allowing the company to remain in Laramie. The incentives included various landscaping projects aimed at enhancing the overall visual appeal of the business park.

"We are proud of this expansion because it is an integral part of our corporate commitment to Laramie and the State of Wyoming," stated Henry R. Richter, President of TriHydro. "TriHydro has had a record of uninterrupted growth and profitability since it was founded 19 years ago. This project will provide us with the opportunity to continue that tradition by marking another major step in our company's efforts for controlled expansion."
