



## **Trihydro Wins National Park Service Civil, Environmental and Sanitary Engineering Contract**

LARAMIE, Wyoming, January 28, 2003--TriHydro Corporation (TriHydro) has been awarded a civil, environmental and sanitary engineering services contract by the Denver Service Center of the National Park Service. The contract will include preliminary design, final design, and construction-phase services for civil, environmental, water, wastewater, and water reclamation facilities throughout the United States, including Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands. The ID/IQ (Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity) contract has a \$10 million ceiling over a five-year period.

To offer experienced management, full-service engineering, environmental, and technical field support services to the NPS, TriHydro has assembled a team that includes Richard P. Arber Associates, Greenberg & Greenberg Architects, J.F. Sato and Associates, Inc., RMH Group, Inc., and EDAW, Inc. Richard P. Collectively, the TriHydro team has completed more than twenty-seven major projects for the National Park Service with a value of more than \$40 million. Projects completed have been similar to those contemplated by this new contract and include work at Yosemite National Park, the Presidio, Mount Rainier National Park, Grand Canyon National Park, Mesa Verde National Park, Rocky Mountain National Park, Joshua Tree, Big Bend National Park, Everglades National Park, Lake Mead National Recreation Area, Gateway National Recreation Area, and the Tonto National Monument.

TriHydro is a Laramie, Wyoming based, HUBZone certified firm specializing in civil/environmental engineering and remediation services. Historically Underutilized Business (HUB)Zones were established under The Small Business Reauthorization Act of 1997 to provide federal contracting assistance for qualified small businesses located in underutilized business zones. TriHydro was awarded the NPS contract based on its certified HUBZone status, experience with similar work, qualifications, past performance, quality of deliverables, timeliness, and geographic locations.
